

Cookie Policy for CAW International

This Cookie Policy explains how **CAW International** (“we”, “us”, or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our website: <https://www.caw.international/>

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device (computer, phone, or tablet) when you visit a website. They help websites work properly and provide information to site owners about how visitors use their site.

2. How we use cookies

We use cookies to:

- Understand how visitors use our website
- Improve website performance and user experience

We **do not** use cookies for advertising or marketing purposes.

3. Cookies we use

We currently only use Google Analytics cookies.

Google Analytics (*_ga* cookies)

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting information such as:

- Number of visitors
- Pages visited
- Time spent on the site
- How users arrived at the site

This data is aggregated and anonymous, meaning it does not directly identify you.

Cookie Name	Purpose	Duration
<i>_ga</i>	Distinguishes unique users	2 years
<i>ga*</i>	Maintains session state	Up to 2 years

4. Legal basis for cookies

Under UK law (Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations – PECR), we will:

- Only set **analytics cookies after you give your consent**
- Provide a clear option to accept or reject cookies when you visit our site

You can withdraw your consent at any time (see section 5 below).

5. Managing your cookie preferences

You can control or disable cookies in several ways:

On our website

- Use our cookie consent banner to accept or reject analytics cookies

In your browser

Most browsers let you:

- View cookies
- Delete cookies
- Block cookies entirely
